Product Quality

This product has been manufactured to meet stated product specifications. If a certificate of calibration is required please contact the nearest authorized REED distributor or authorized Service Center. Please note an additional fee for this service will apply.

Safety

Never attempt to repair or modify your instrument. Dismantling your product, other than for the purpose of replacing batteries, may cause damage that will not be covered under the manufacturer's warranty. Servicing should only be provided by an authorized service center.

- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations and keep away from children. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household trash or incinerate.
- Even used batteries may cause severe injury or death.
- Call a local poison control center for treatment information.
- Identification of compatible battery type: LR44
- Nominal battery voltage: 1.50V
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Do not force discharge, recharge, disassemble, heat above 140°F (60°C) or incinerate. Doing so may result in injury due to venting, leakage or explosion resulting in chemical burns.
- Ensure the batteries are installed correctly according to polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries, different brands or types of batteries, such as alkaline, carbon-zinc, or rechargeable batteries.
- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of batteries from equipment not used for an extended period of time according to local regulations.
- · Always completely secure the battery compartment. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product, remove the batteries, and keep them away from children.



Instrument Description



- 1. LCD Display
- 2. ON/OFF Button
- 3. Calibration Screw

- 4. °F/°C Button
- 5. Temperature Probe
- 6. Protective Cover

Operating Instructions

- Turn the meter on by pressing the ON/OFF button. To turn the meter off, press the ON/OFF button again.
- Prior to taking a measurement, remove the thermometer from the protective sleeve.
- 3. Insert the thermometer stem at least ½" into the testing material.

Note: Do not force the probe into solid or semi-solid materials.

4. Press the °F/°C button to toggle between Fahrenheit and Celsius.

Note: When the meter is first powered on the default unit of measure is Fahrenheit (°F).

5. To preserve battery life, the meter is programmed to turn off after approximately 10 minutes of inactivity.

Calibration Instructions

- 1. Fill a container with crushed ice.
- 2. Add water until ice is completely submerged.
- 3. Add more ice to ensure it is packed tightly at the bottom of the container.
- Insert the thermometer stem and allow to stabilize for approximately 3-5
 minutes, while not allowing the tip to touch the bottom of the container
- If the unit does not measure 32°F (0°C) once the reading has stabilized, slowly turn the calibration screw using a flat head screwdriver until the meter measures 32°F (0°C).

Note: Turn the calibration screw to the left to decrease the temperature value or to the right to increase the temperature value.

Battery Replacement

- Open the battery door by sliding a flathead screwdriver under the lip of the rubber battery door.
- 2. When open, tap the unit against your hand to make the battery slide out.
- 3. Insert a new LR44 battery.
- 4. Push the rubber door in firmly so that the battery is all the way in position.
